Special childcare programme at the University of Groningen

(for visiting lecturers/visiting researchers, during conferences, in ad-hoc situations)



In the summer of 2010 the University of Groningen started a three year pilot project offering childcare services to guest lecturers/guest researchers, and to participants of conferences organized by staff of the University. This special childcare programme has been organized in cooperation with the *Groningen City Childcare Association (SKSG)*. SKSG runs 30 day care centres in the Municipality of Groningen and also organizes out-of-school care.

In September 2011 the pilot program was extended to include childcare for ad-hoc situations, such as for a sick child while the parent needs to give a lecture. This service is offered to RUG employees in cooperation with *Regeltante.nl*.

All three forms of childcare are intended for children aged 0-13 years.

Application procedure

Guest lecturers/guest researchers

If you, a guest lecturer/guest researcher, wish to make use of this childcare service, please complete the application form and e-mail it to Ms. Delinah Halvorson-Molen, department of HR-Innovation. Please attach a written confirmation (letter or e-mail) from your Faculty Board or P&O department indicating for which period you will be a guest lecturer/guest researcher.

HR-Innovation will then try to arrange the childcare in cooperation with SKSG. You will receive a confirmation by e-mail.

Conferences

If you are a member of the University staff organizing a conference and you wish to offer childcare facilities, please send an e-mail to Ms Delinah Halvorson-Molen of HR-Innovation.

After receipt of your e-mail, we will register your application and register you with SKSG. You will be sent a confirmation e-mail, which you can refer to when contacting SKSG for further details about days, times and locations of childcare facilities.

Ad-hoc situations

If you, as a University employee, would like to use this form of childcare, please send an e-mail to Ms. Delinah Halvorson-Molen of HR-Innovation. After agreement, you will receive a special code with which you can register on the website of Regeltante.nl. Subsequently you will receive a phone call from Regeltante.nl to aid you in finding a child-minder. In urgent cases, you can also contact Regeltante.nl directly yourself.

Costs

Childcare services are free for visiting lecturers and researchers, as well as for conference participants during conferences. The University of Groningen will pay the costs thanks to a grant received from the Elsevier Foundation for this special childcare programme. In certain circumstances you may be required to pay part of the costs yourself.

Regarding ad-hoc childcare, the University pays for the support Regeltante.nl offers for finding a child-minder. You will then need to negotiate the hourly rate with the child-minder, which you will be responsible for paying.
